NEW LOOK FOR LEGACY

The Legacy Club at Alaqua Lakes Begins Greens and Clubhouse Updates

Champion is an ultra-dwarf Bermuda grass that allows very low heights of cut and produces excellent putting surfaces.

In conjunction to the greens project, the Clubhouse will also be undergoing a renovation. The project will feature an expanded dining room, a new ladies locker room, ladies social area and state-of-the-art meeting spaces. Once completed, these improvements will complement the already completed Men's Locker Room and Golf Shop renovations.
